Subject: Polish State aid

Since 4 September 2018, the Republic of Poland has had a law in force concerning the granting of public aid to certain entrepreneurs for the realisation of new investments (Journal of Laws 2018, item 1713). In principle, State aid is prohibited under Article 107(1) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU). It is only acceptable if it is compatible with the internal market under Article 107(2) and (3) TFEU.

1. Has the Polish law been approved or reviewed by the Commission under competition law? If so, when?
2. How exactly is this aid compatible with the internal market under Article 107(2) and (3) TFEU?
